





Advent, which means "coming," is the four week period immediately before Christmas.



Send thy peace, O Lord, that all people have love in their hearts.



The only true One, and the last.









It made me think that you have choices in life!


I have felt bitterness and anger.

I now choose strength, happiness and compassion








If hope could be a feeling it would be holding a newborn baby in your arms close to your heart.


If hope could be an animal, it would be an eagle soaring beyond the bounds of the tip of mountains high above the world below.

He smiled at me, warming up my frozen heart. Tears, like ice, melting.








